



**Examinations - Review of Results
Advice from Queen Elizabeth's Grammar School**

- The school will review all grades that have been awarded at A Level and GCSE.
- If we think that there is an anomaly with your grade, **you will be contacted directly to discuss this and we will advise you upon the next actions that you should take.**
- Please be aware that in all other circumstances the decision to request a review of marking is yours. **Teachers do not have the capacity to review student papers within the required exam board deadlines** and will therefore not be able to advise on individual papers.
- It is very important to remember that **grades can increase or decrease** following a marking review. Unless you are extremely close (2 marks or less) to an upper grade boundary, requesting a review of marking is always a potential risk to your overall grade, as the marks awarded might be lowered during the review process.
- We would advise that you check the grade boundaries to help you make an informed decision, you can do this by clicking the links below to the various exam boards.
- **Our advice is to be cautious about requesting a review of results, unless you have been contacted directly by a member of staff.**
