

Governance Structure 2024-25

The Members of Queen Elizabeth's Grammar School agree that the Board of Trustees will be called the Governing Body with the Trustees being known as Governors.

The Governing Body will consist of Trustees (as per the Articles of Association) as follows:

- Staff Trustees (1 will automatically be the Head Teacher)
- Foundation Trustees
- Parent Trustees
- Co-opted Trustees
- Up to 6 Member Appointed Trustees

The Governing Body will always operate in accordance with the requirements of the Education Act; the Academy Trust Handbook; Funding agreements; the Articles of Association and all other relevant ESFA updates and legislation.

The purpose of governance is to provide confident, strategic leadership and to create robust accountability, oversight and assurance for educational and financial performance
The Governing Body has resolved to conduct its business by adopting a committee structure and delegation, with the Committee Terms of Reference outlining those responsibilities wholly delegated to those committees.
