



Application for a 16-19 Bursary

The Discretionary Bursary Fund is a fund made available by the government to support students in completing their education and is targeted at students who face the greatest financial barriers in doing so.

Students who have successfully applied for this award will receive money to contribute towards the purchases that support their education. This can include, but is not limited to, transport costs, course textbooks, educational website, magazine and journal subscriptions, educational trips, attending university open days, equipment linked to studies (including laptops), dress code items and other items at the school's discretion.

The 16-19 Bursary is awarded by the school on a discretionary basis. Students can apply for the Bursary if fulfilling the following criteria:

1. The student is over 16 and under 19.
2. The student must satisfy Education Funding Agency residency criteria – meaning you normally live in the UK.
3. The student must provide evidence of receipt of benefits or gross household income of less than £35,000.

Students who do not satisfy any of the criteria listed in this section, but who are able to demonstrate financial hardship arising from other reasons, may also apply for a discretionary bursary.
